## **5th International competition for young string players, dedicated to Victor Radovich 100th Anniversary**

### **Regulations**

#### **Purposes and Objectives:**

1. To develop the professionalism and musical tastes of young musician, revealing violinist Professor V. Radovich's pedagogical principles.
2. To expand educational string repertoire, including contemporary music.
3. To create favorable conditions for students to play, develop their artistic taste and self-expression.
4. To develop stage experience and joy of playing.

#### **Date and Location:**

**Vilnius Naujoji Vilnia Music School (Karklėnų str. 9, LT- 11223 Vilnius);  
November 30 – December 1, 2019  
Competition Opening at 10:00 a.m.**

#### **Competition requirements:**

1. Participants must perform 2 pieces:
  - a) a free choice composition
  - b) a virtuosic piece
2. All pieces must be performed by heart.

#### **Rules:**

1. Competition is open to string players (violin, viola, cello, double bass) of all nationalities from children's music and art schools of Lithuania and foreign countries.
2. Participants will be divided in two groups: professional education and non-formal education categories.
3. Participants are divided into 4 age groups:

#### **Non-formal education category:**

**A group 7 – 9 years**  
**B group 10 – 12 years**  
**C group 13 – 15 years**  
**D group 16 – 19 years**

#### **Professional education category:**

- A group 7 – 9 years**  
**B group 10 – 12 years**  
**C group 13 – 15 years**  
**D group 16 – 19 years (max. duration of the program is 30 min.)**

1. Competitors will be evaluated by a competent jury, which will be announced at the beginning of the competition. The jury decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
2. The winners of the Competition will be awarded with diplomas of the laureates and diplomats and the commemorative gifts.
3. Special Prize- Participation at a concert-ceremony organized by the Department of String Instruments of the Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theater for prof. 100th Anniversary of V. Radovičius.
